When shipping samples to Material Bank, the below is required to ensure your items are received timely and efficiently without unnecessary charges, errors, or delays.

We strongly recommend that Brand Partners book a discharge slot with the hub in advance of shipment.

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Inbound shipment document requirements

Advanced Shipping Notice must be submitted prior to delivery (review next section for more details).

- All goods must be custom cleared by the Brand Partner (further details on last section).
- Advanced Shipping Notice must be submitted prior to delivery (review next section for more details).
- The packing list must be facing outward on the pallet or box in clear view and contain the following information:
 - Brand name
 - Shipper reference number
 - Carrier name
 - Brand SKU(s)
 - SKU description(s)
 - Number of samples per SKU
 - Total number of cartons
- New SKUs that arrive at our Hub without prior notice will be held for a maximum of 30 days.

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Inbound advance shipment notification requirements

All inbound shipments must have an ASN (advanced shipping notice) submitted in Material Bank's brand services team at brandservices.eu@materialbank.com:

1. The receipt will be placed at the end of the receiving queue and the 72-hour service level agreement will begin once all information is provided to Material Bank
2. Brand will be notified of receipt and an ASN will be requested
3. Brand will have 24 hours to provide an ASN
4. If ASN is not received within 24 hours, Material Bank will create a manual Inbound Order and receive samples
5. Brand will incur charges for Inbound Orders generated by Material Bank (€500/shipment)

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Barcode specifications


Material Bank requires the use of Code 128 or Code 39 barcode format (see below). Barcodes should translate to the Manufacturer SKU. The sizing of the label should be no smaller than 8x 25mm. For UPC or EAN barcodes, brands are responsible for providing translations. For more information on how to generate barcodes, please reference our Barcode Guide [here](#). For samples that arrive at Material Bank without barcodes, brands will be charged a barcoding fee of €0,20/piece.

Shipment past 30 days:

New SKUs that arrive at our hub without prior notice will be held for a maximum of 30 days. After 30 days, inventory will be shipped back at the brand's expense (€500 + shipping cost).


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Pallet and Carton Specifications

For palletized shipments

- 1016 x 1219 cm pallet – Maximum dimensions (including pallet)
- 4-way entry pallet




- Maximum pallet height (including pallet) is 155 cm
- Cartons cannot overhang the dimensions of the pallet. If palletized as shown below in incorrect photo, cartons will be at risk of arriving damaged to our Hub




Pallet and Carton Specifications

All materials on a pallet must be secured to prevent shifting of cartons and materials with shrink wrap (preferred), strapping, binding, or skid corners.


Labeling guidelines and shipping label placement

Cartons on pallets

Each carton must be individually labeled or have the required information stamped on the carton. All labels should be visible on the perimeter of the pallet whenever possible (see picture below).

Carton labels must include the following information

- Brand name
- SKU description
- Quantity in carton



Shipping labels should be located on the top of the pallet, away from any packing tape

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Carton and Pallet Packing Requirements

Carton packing

1. Samples should be packed tightly within carton using bubble wrap, dunnage, or partitions to minimize potential damages
2. Samples should be bundled together if cartons are mixed
3. Shipping cartons should have a minimum of a 32-pound crush rating. For heavy samples, double wall boxes are suggested to minimize risk of damage
4. Mixed cartons should be clearly labeled as “Mixed”
5. Samples within the carton should be labeled with the following information:
 - Manufacturer SKU
 - Description
 - Color
 - Barcode (if applicable)

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Carton and Pallet Packing Requirements

Non-Compliance Fees

Charges will be invoiced monthly for any non-compliance issues during Material Bank's receiving process.

Please refer to the "Non-Compliance Fees" breakdown section for specific charge amounts. Material Bank's requirements are needed to process receipts efficiently and timely in order to meet service level agreements. Deviations from these requirements result in delays and incremental labor.

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Carton and Pallet Packing Requirements

Non-Compliance Fees

1. Failure to provide advanced shipping notice (ASN)
€500/shipment
2. Failure to provide physical packing list
€500/shipment
3. Barcode labeling
€0.20/piece
4. Shipments past 30 days
€500 + shipping cost
5. Failure to provide custom clearance
€200 + clearance fees

*** NON-COMPLIANCE CHARGES ARE CUMULATIVE**
(Multiple charges per shipment may occur)

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Custom Clearance

Brand Partners are responsible for Custom Clearance of all the sample shipments to Material Bank when applicable (when shipping from outside of the European Union). Each shipment needs to include all of the details below. Failure to comply with the below will incur the specified custom clearance non-compliance fees.

- Commercial Invoice (see examples below)
- Delivered duty paid (DDP) or prepaid terms. This means that the brand is responsible
- Use “Samples - Not for Resale” as the terms of sale
- Provide customs with Material Bank’s importer details:
